READ TOGETHER

Titus 3:3-7

1. What are some ways you see a difference in your life since you came into a relationship with Jesus?
2. How would you define the word grace? How is it different from mercy?
3. When you think of all that Jesus has done for you, does it inspire devotion? How so?

LIVE IT

Everyone is devoted to something. For some, it's good grades, sports accolades, or maybe being popular. Whatever is most important to you is where you're devoted. You can tell by the amount of time, energy and resources that you put into it.

Paul recounts to Titus the good news of the gospel (3:4-7). If we're going to claim to follow Christ, then He should be what is truly most valuable to us. It should show up in our attitude, actions, words and the small things we do every day.
